Contract Length: The post will be permanent and commence as soon as possible

Working Hours: 10 hours per week, Monday to Friday in term time (39 weeks). Just before or just after the school day. Flexibility required.

Salary: NJC A1-2 Hourly rate – £11.59

Qualifications: Previous experience is not essential, as full training will be given. It is essential that you are capable of regular stooping, bending, lifting, and carrying of equipment, materials, and furniture.

Applicants must have authorisation to work in the UK.

No formal qualifications required, though literacy and numeracy skills required to be able to read instructions and work out simple measurements.

Typical Tasks

Clean toilets, bowls, sinks and basins

Wipe down desks and chairs

Vacuum and tidy classrooms

Wash worktops/tables

Wash/mop/sweep floors and wash wet areas

Clean inside glazing

Dust and polish

Use buffer

Undertake routine maintenance of equipment (e.g. vacuum bags)

Empty bins and dispose of rubbish

Ensure safe and effective use and storage of all equipment

Be aware of Health and Safety at Work regulations and COSHH guidelines

Draw to caretaker's attention any problems/issues which may affect the safety or security of the school or its users.
