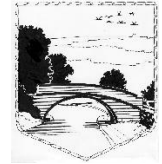

Little Lawrences session, funding and fees information

Little Lawrences is open Monday to Friday, term time only, between 8.45am and 3.15pm

Additional wrap around care is provided by our before-school (Larks) and after-school (Owls) club, known as Larks 'n' Owls. This is available from 7.30am and until 6.00pm

Funding

We accept funding to cover the cost of education and care and please note this cannot be used to pay for meals, extra activities such as music lessons or trips.

We accept the following Primary Government Funding Streams (Entitlements)

- **15 Hours Universal Entitlement**: For all 3 and 4-year-olds in England, covering 570 hours per year.
30 Hours Extended Entitlement: For 3 and 4-year-olds with eligible working parents, covering 1,140 hours per year. You can use your 30 hours between 7.30am and 6pm for a maximum of 10 hours a day. 30 hours funding can be split between childcare providers but at no more than 2 settings each day.
- **2-Year-Old Funding**: For eligible working families (15/30 hours) and disadvantaged 2-year-olds. Please note: we accept children from their 3rd birthday but we are able to claim 2 year old funding, where applicable, from their start date.

We accept the following Additional Funding and Support

- **Tax-Free Childcare**: Government adds £2 for every £8 spent by parents, up to £2,000 per child per year.
- **Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP)**: Extra funding (approx. £376 per year) for providers to support disadvantaged 3-4 year olds.
- **Disability Access Fund (DAF)**: Over £900+ per year to support providers in making adjustments for children receiving Disability Living Allowance (DLA).
- **Special Educational Needs Inclusion Fund (SENIF)**: Funding to support children with emerging SEN.
- **Universal Credit/Tax Credits**: Low-income families can claim back up to 85% of childcare costs.

We also accept

- **Child vouchers or employer-supported childcare**: for registered clubs, such as Little Lawrences sessions, wraparound care (Larks 'n' Owls) and sports clubs.

Please note

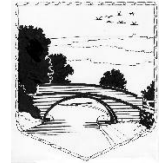
- There is no requirement for a deposit or registration fee to be paid
- Before-school (Larks) fees are charged separately via our School Money App and after-school club (Owls) fees are invoiced separately to fees for Little Lawrences
- The private hourly rate (other than between 12 noon and 1:15pm) is set at £6.00
- You can use part of the 30 hours entitlement for Larks 'n' Owls fees
- Little Lawrences fees are reviewed annually or as required
- Fees are payable within 7 days and in full upon receipt of an invoice. Failure to pay may result in your child losing their place.

In the event of the school being closed due to snow or other exceptional circumstances, sessions will still be charged. We will do our best to offer alternative sessions. However, we are not able to guarantee them (especially if sessions are already fully booked).
